Alan Leshner, Ph.D., has been chief executive officer of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS), the world's largest, multidisciplinary scientific and engineering society, and executive publisher of the journal Science since 2001.

From 1994-2001 he was director of the National Institute on Drug Abuse, which supports more than 85 percent of the world's research on the health aspects of drug abuse and addiction. Previously Dr. Leshner was the deputy director and acting director of the National Institute of Mental Health and held a variety of senior positions with the National Science Foundation. Prior to the NSF, Dr. Leshner was a professor of psychology at Bucknell University and held other long-term appointments at Postgraduate Medical School in Budapest, Hungary; at the Wisconsin Regional Primate Research Center; and as a Fulbright Scholar at the Weizmann Institute of Science in Israel.

Adrienne Arsht is a community leader, philanthropist, and University of Miami trustee. Her gift, equal to the largest ever to support an ethics program in Florida, is funding a suite of University-wide, interdisciplinary initiatives: an ethics debate series, a distinguished speakers program, and a research program. Now in their 23rd year, UM Ethics Programs foster and support a range of efforts and activities dedicated to education, research, and community service in ethics. Directed by UM professors Anita Cava and Kenneth Goodman, the Ethics Programs emphasize work in bioethics, business and professional ethics, and scientific ethics.
